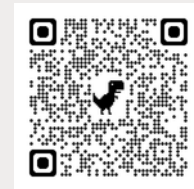
Enabling and Boundaries in Family Recovery (6hr)

This full-day training provides information on how enabling behaviors develop as family members search for a way to cope with active addiction and fears of relapse in recovery. It will help participants understand the relationship between Substance Use Disorder, recovery and enabling behaviors. Healthy boundaries are important in creating good relationships within a recovering family. This training examines how to identify healthy and unhealthy boundaries and how to communicate boundaries to family members, colleagues, and consumers/clients.

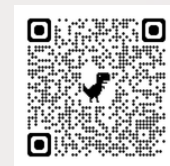
